Awards will be given to 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each class except (H) and (I).

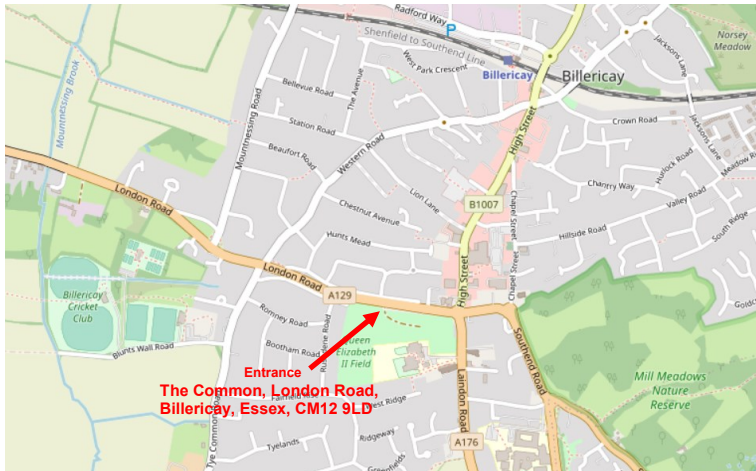
NB, Major trophy winners in last year's show and winners of other major events in the last 12 months MUST enter classes (A) or (B).
